

Rule Amendments of Thoroughbred Racing - 2012

Rule 31 (8) a) is amended as follows:

a) except as provided by Rule 31 (8) b), a horse shall not be entered in a race if it is wholly or partly owned by, trained by, or under the management of, an unlicensed person, a person whose license is under suspension or a person who acts in concert with or under the control of a person whose license is under suspension.

Rule 31 (8) b) is amended as follows:

b) if any entry from an unlicensed person or a person whose license is under suspension or of an ineligible horse is received such entry shall be void and any money paid for such entry shall be returned if the facts are disclosed one hour before post time for the race; except that a horse may be entered by an unlicensed owner/trainer but may not start unless the license application has been approved by the MHRC by 10:00 a.m. the day of the race in question.

Rule Amendments of Thoroughbred Racing - 2012

Rule 1 (dd) is amended as follows:

Licensee – shall mean any person issued a license by the Commission and for the purpose of enforcement of the Rules shall include persons on the grounds of the Association carrying on an activity for which they are required by the Rules to be licensed by the Commission.
