DIRECTIVE 2015/03

With regard to Rule 43 (3) q)

A trainer will be deemed to have under his “care & control” a banned substance if the banned substance is found in his shedrow. The trainer may be absolved of his responsibility if:

- a) he proves he had no knowledge of the substance
- b) he proves that he could not have had knowledge if acting reasonably in accordance with industry standards
- c) he proves that no employee of his had knowledge and could not have had knowledge acting reasonably as per industry standards

All proof is on the balance of probabilities. This Directive does not alter a persons Responsibility for banned substances found elsewhere as set out in the Rules.

DIRECTIVE 2015/04

For the purpose of Rule 27 (6) for administration of the lasix program in addition to those persons allowed by the rule and directive to administer shots any person approved by the MHRC Executive Director may also administer a lasix shot; provided that other procedures set out by the Rule and Directive are adhered to; no appeal from Executive Director.

THOROUGHBRED RULES

DIRECTIVE 2015/05

For the purpose of Rule 35 (2) a horse may be entered if:

- a) in a claiming race any horse entered for a price is subject to be claimed for its entered price by any person who is eligible to claim or by his authorized agent.
- b) at time of entry into a claiming race, the owner/trainer or authorized agent may opt to declare a horse ineligible to be claimed provided:
 - i) the horse has been laid off and has not started for a minimum of 180 days since its last race, and
 - ii) the horse is entered for a claiming price equal to or greater than the price at which it last started;
 - iii) failure to declare the horse ineligible at the time of entry may not be remedied;
 - iv) ineligibility shall apply only to the first start following such layoff.
 - v) this rule does not apply to the marathon series.
